The week will end with a Winter-Olympic themed performance for family and friends!

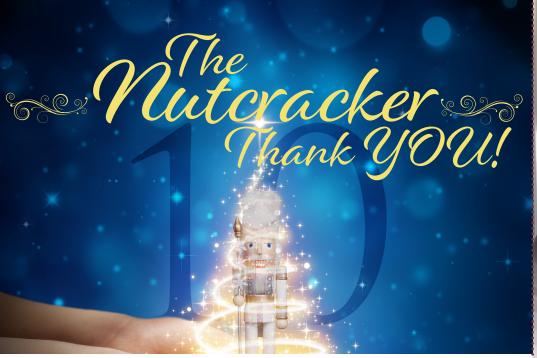
